

# Thinking of travelling to Croatia?



## 5 entry requirement options:

01/09/2021 – 15/09/2021

We cannot wait to welcome you to our beautiful country and are dedicated to keeping you, our people and other visitors as safe as possible, so you can explore with peace of mind.

To support this we ask that you fulfil and evidence **1 of the following 5** criteria to be allowed access to Croatia.



A **negative PCR** (taken 72 hours before arrival at the border) or **antigen test** taken (48 hours before arrival).



**Proof of recovery** and **first dose of vaccination** more than 11 days and less than 270 days ago.



A **vaccination certificate** showing final dose taken more than 14 days ago.



Pay for a **test** on arrival and remain in **self-isolation** until a negative result.



**Proof of recovery** from Covid more than 11 days and less than 270 days ago.

## Visiting from outside of the EU?



Don't forget, you will also need to show evidence that you own property in Croatia or have paid for accommodation, be that in a hotel, camp site, private rental, boat or other tourism provider.

## Are you visiting from the UK, Russia or Cyprus?

If so, regardless of whether you have been vaccinated and/or recovered from Covid – effective July 26th you will be required to provide evidence of a negative PCR or antigen test performed in the home country before entering the territory of the Republic of Croatia.

## A few things to note...



All tests taken and used as supporting evidence of a positive or negative result must be recognized by European Union.



All children under the age of 12 are exempt from providing test results should their parent or guardian fulfil the requirements.
