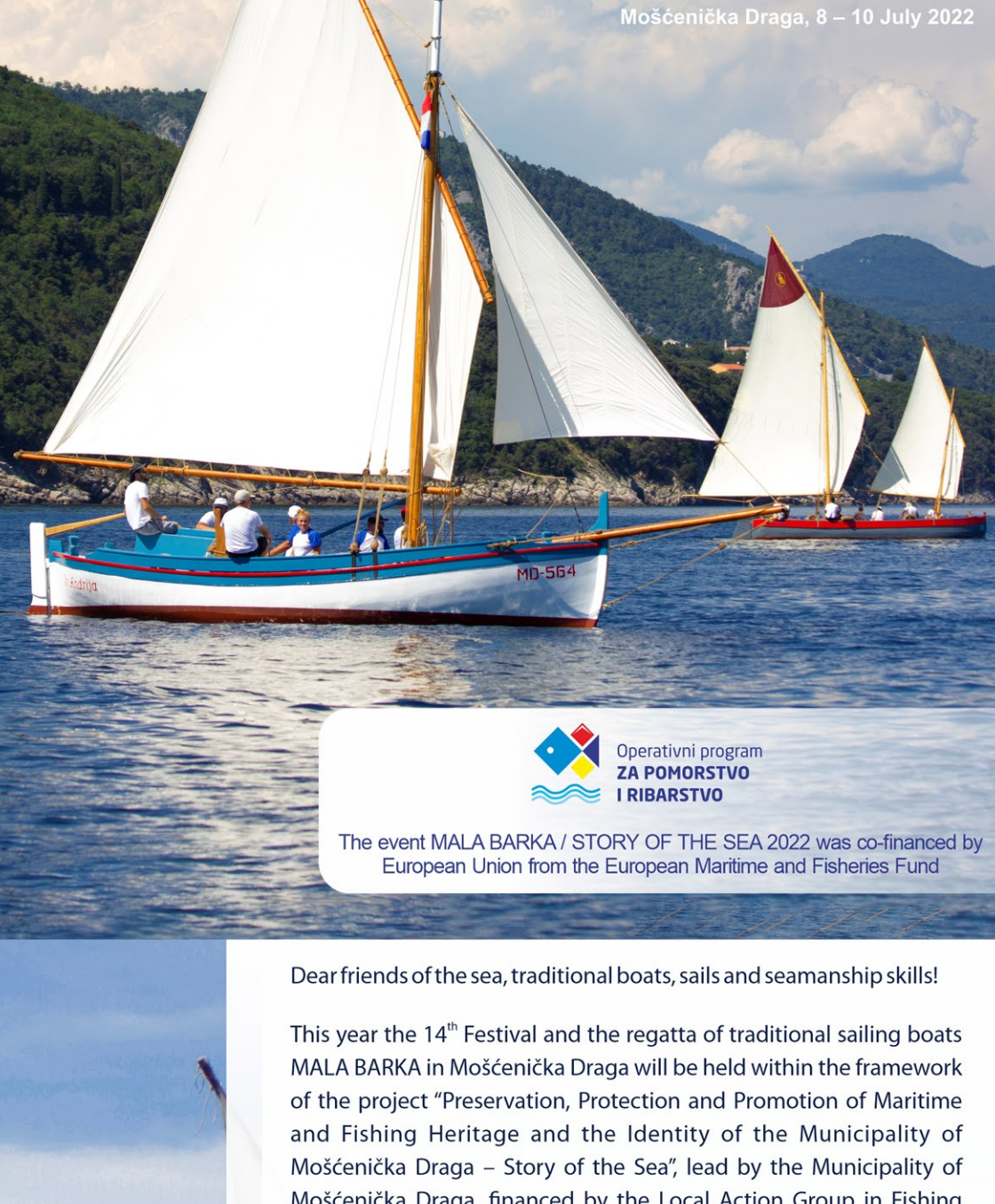

MALA BARKA STORY OF THE SEA

14th Festival and regatta of traditional sailing boats Mošćenička Draga, 8 – 10 July 2022



The event MALA BARKA / STORY OF THE SEA 2022 was co-financed by European Union from the European Maritime and Fisheries Fund

Dear friends of the sea, traditional boats, sails and seamanship skills!

This year the 14th Festival and the regatta of traditional sailing boats MALA BARKA in Mošćenička Draga will be held within the framework of the project "Preservation, Protection and Promotion of Maritime and Fishing Heritage and the Identity of the Municipality of Mošćenička Draga – Story of the Sea", lead by the Municipality of Mošćenička Draga, financed by the Local Action Group in Fishing (LAGUR) "Vela Vrata" from the European Maritime and Fisheries Fund. The manifestation is supported by the Primorje-Gorski Kotar County and the Kvarner Tourist Board.

The organizers of the manifestation are the Ecomuseum Mošćenička Draga in cooperation with the Chair of the Chakavian Assembly of the Municipality Mošćenička Draga (Section for Traditional Boats Draga Boats), the Tourist Board and the Municipality Mošćenička Draga.

This year's manifestation, the 14th Festival and regatta of traditional sailing boats – MALA BARKA / STORY OF THE SEA 2022, offers a rich and interesting programme, which besides a very attractive night regatta with about twenty traditional wooden boats like guc, pasara, gajeta, leut, batana and others equipped with traditional sails (lug sail, Lateen sail, gaff sail, dipping lug sail), also includes the exhibition race of the traditional boats accompanied by music, a demonstration of boat heeling in the sea to maintain the hull, beaching the boats on shore as they did a hundred years ago, a festival of traditional boats sailing at night in front of the Mošćenička Draga quay with light effects and music, thematic exhibitions and lectures, as well as interesting workshops of traditional shipbuilding and seafaring skills workshops. The manifestation will be enriched by the arrival of the Lošinj lugger Nerezinac (interpretation centre of the Lošinj maritime heritage). Besides the part of the programme intended for the presentation of the maritime heritage, the manifestation will also bring attractive music and artistic events. As a part of the manifestation, there will also be a fair of Kvarner eco-ethnic products, while the restaurants will offer dishes based on autochthonous ingredients from Kvarner and a special menu dedicated to the manifestation.

We would hereby like to invite all friends of the sea, traditional boats, sails and seafaring skills to join us and enjoy in this attractive manifestation and the holiday of our maritime heritage together with us.

Kvarner

Kvarner – another name for Primorsko-Goranska County, is one of Croatia's most developed and attractive tourist destinations. It encompasses three different sub-regions: the coastal areas of the Opatica Riviera, the city of Rijeka and its surroundings, and the Crikvenica-Novi Vinodolski Riviera; the islands of Krk, Rab, Cres and Lošinj; and the mountainous hinterland of Gorski kotar. Thanks primarily to its unique blend of coast, islands and highlands, the slogan of the Kvarner region is Diversity is Beautiful. In the language of the ancient Romans, who are believed to have given the region its name, the word *Qua(te)rmaris* means "four cardinal points", which implies that Kvarner is a place where these four points meet. Besides the combination of an excellent geographical position and a mild Mediterranean climate, this is a privileged area where various influences intertwined for centuries. Today Kvarner is a modern, attractive tourist destination for all generations, a destination of health, rich in natural and cultural heritage, a region of scents and aromas, good wine and excellent cuisine.

About us

Mošćenička Draga, a former fishing village, and today an attractive tourist resort, benefits from its ideal location on the coast of beautiful Kvarner Bay at the foot of Mount Učka and Učka Nature Park. Mošćenička Draga is distinguished by its pebble beaches, which the American website Business Insider included on its list of the most beautiful Croatian beaches in 2015. History lovers should make sure they visit the nearby medieval hilltop towns of Mošćenice and Brseč, while those looking for a more action-packed holiday can take advantage of the walking trails along the coast and on the slopes of Mount Učka. The Trebišća-Perun history and mythology trail is particularly worth mentioning. If you are visiting Mošćenička Draga during the 14th Festival and regatta of traditional sailing boats, make sure you visit the *House of the Sea* – the interpretation centre of fishing and maritime heritage of Mošćenička Draga municipality, but also do not miss out on the rich offer of autochthonous food in the local restaurants and taverns, not only in Mošćenička Draga but also in the quaint hilltop town of Mošćenice.
